**Adult Baptism:** The R.C.I.A. program sees to the needs of adults who wish to become Catholic.

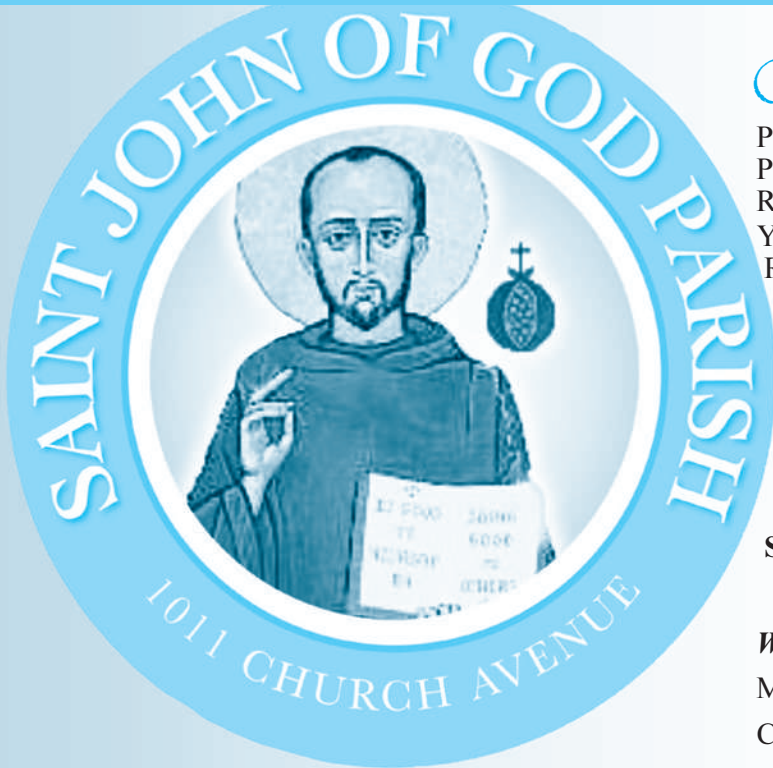
**Reconciliation (Confession):** 3:30 PM to 4:15 PM (Church) and following the 4:30 PM Mass (Church) and by appointment.

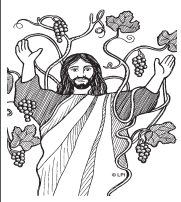

**TEN COMMANDMENTS:** The most important Top Ten list not given by David Letterman.

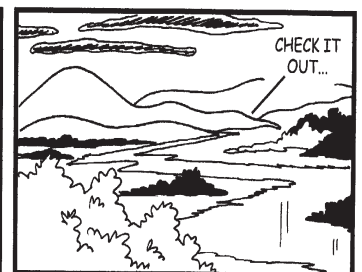
**USHERS:** The only people in the parish who don't know the seating capacity of a pew.
